# **Warnimont Dog Exercise Area Grand Opening**

On Friday, August 6, at 10 a.m., Warnimont Park will have a grand opening ceremony of the new Warnimont Dog Exercise Area. Honored visitors include Parks Director Sue Black (with her dog, Ranger), Cudahy Mayor Tony Day, and Cudahy Police Chief Thomas Poellot.

Bring your own dog! Each dog must be licensed and have proof of current rabies vaccination. Free dog treats are available and you will also have the chance to enter to win great prizes. Sheridan Park Friends will sponsor banjo music. Fixx Coffee House will be serving delicious beverages at Warnimont Dog Exercise Area from a kiosk open through mid-November.



Dog licenses and dog park permits can be obtained at the grand opening. Annual permits are \$25 for Milwaukee County residents although seniors and people with disabilities pay \$15. Visitors may park in the southern parking lot of Kelly Senior Center (6100 S. Lake Dr., Cudahy) to access this area on the southern edge of Warnimont Park, just north of College Avenue.

# O'Donnell Parking Garage Update

On Thursday, July 29, 2010, the full County Board received a report from our Director of Public Works following the tragedy that resulted from a panel falling from the O'Donnell facility. Further reports will be forthcoming as we continue to investigate. Up to \$300,000 is being spent immediately to conduct a system-wide review of county buildings with mortar construction. In addition, a review is underway regarding the parking garage and the extent of repairs that will be needed going forward.

### **Hoan Bridge**



On July 27, my office received a letter signed by Frank Busalacchi of the Wisconsin DOT. Busalacchi confirmed that WisDOT will begin an in-depth structural investigation of the Hoan Bridge. This investigation will provide the information needed to determine the amount of work necessary to replace the existing deck surface. I was also pleased to learn that the TIGER II grant, which is a

federal highway grant for bridges and other structures, has been completed by WisDOT. If we receive such a grant, monies would be used to improve part of the Hoan structure and ramps.

While these are positive steps, I am still pushing for a *full* re-decking of the bridge to preserve the structure over the long term.
